06/20/0422/F Former Pontins site, Beach Road Hemsby - 188 dwellings & 91 holiday lodges, new shop, leisure centre, gym & spa, café & communal areas. The Parish Council are due to visit this site w/c 12 October 2020 & they have been granted an extension by GYBC to respond after the date of this meeting.
