

Village Hall report 2021

The management committee closed the hall in early March last year just before the country went in to lock down. We have spent the time of closure wisely and have installed a new fire alarm system, the carpet in St Marys room has been replaced and a new kitchen has been fitted, the walls have had a freshen up with a new coat of paint and wifi has been installed, all electrics are now updated and tested.

Earlier in the year the car park at the hall end was tidied up to prevent the puddles that were forming.

All going well we can welcome our regular users back from Tuesday 18th May and will be taking bookings for functions from June 21st.

We were approached by GYBC to do 2 days of lateral flow tests in February and were more than happy to accommodate them , they reported that the uptake at the hall was the best they had in all the venues and all results were negative, the hall will be open for the local elections on May 6th and all guidelines will be adhered to .

The hall will be putting a book exchange in the main entrance for all villagers to use, this will be locked away behind the hall shutter at night for safety reasons.
