We hope all the PC agree this is a good thing as then the PC and community will have a chance to give their views and help make decisions that will be made regardless of our involvement. There are consultations out on these coastal issues now.

We explained we have questions in the survey on this and Icarus are still analysing the results of their survey and are having another meeting towards the end of October.

This again highlights the importance of Councillors, coastal groups , businesses and the whole community to get involved in the NP because of the need to help get the right evidence and outcomes for Hemsby though policy in the Neighbourhood Plan.
